Saint Guilhem also offers another building listed as World Heritage by UNESCO, the Devil's Bridge, in the heart of the Gorges de l'Hérault.

The day will end with a visit of the famous Grotte de Clamouse. Discovered in 1945, the galleries were forged over many millenniums leaving us a legacy of subterranean marvel, unique in its diversity and rarity of its consecrations.
